I am writing this letter on behalf of Team Endless Sports, LLC. We are a company that provides skill development training in basketball, football, tennis, and baseball to youth in the Washington DC metropolitan area. Violence is a nationwide epidemic especially in urban communities that lack funds and resources to keep our children busy and active.

Team Endless initiated its violence prevention program in May 2014 at the Mary Virginia Merrick Center in Southeast DC. To date we have serviced over 100 youth ages 6 – 18 years of age utilizing basketball skill training and development as an instrument. We were recently afforded an opportunity from the Suburban Coalition – a well-known sports league in the DC area, to enter 40 youth (4 teams) into their Youth Summer League on August 2-3, 2014 at no cost. Thus far we lack adequate resources and equipment; namely, basketball jerseys to service these children. We have reached out to various DC agencies and have not received any financial support or donations.
